

Petition for 27th Ward Voters:

Off-Street Free Parking for Fulton Market Construction Workers



Across America, cities require developers to provide off-street parking for construction workers, to avoid inconvenience to the community during construction. Fulton Market deserves this too.

For our residents, businesses, customers and visitors, on-street parking is near impossible, in part due to the many construction workers parking on our streets.

Our community welcomes new developments, and we honor the hard-working construction employees. For new developments receiving City of Chicago zoning changes for larger buildings, developers should provide free off-street parking for their construction workers. Nearby parking lots and vacant lots can accommodate them.

This policy would apply to Fulton Market developments gaining zoning changes in the area bordered by Halsted St. to Ashland Ave. and Washington Blvd. to Grand Ave. City Hall can include this policy in its negotiation with the developer.
